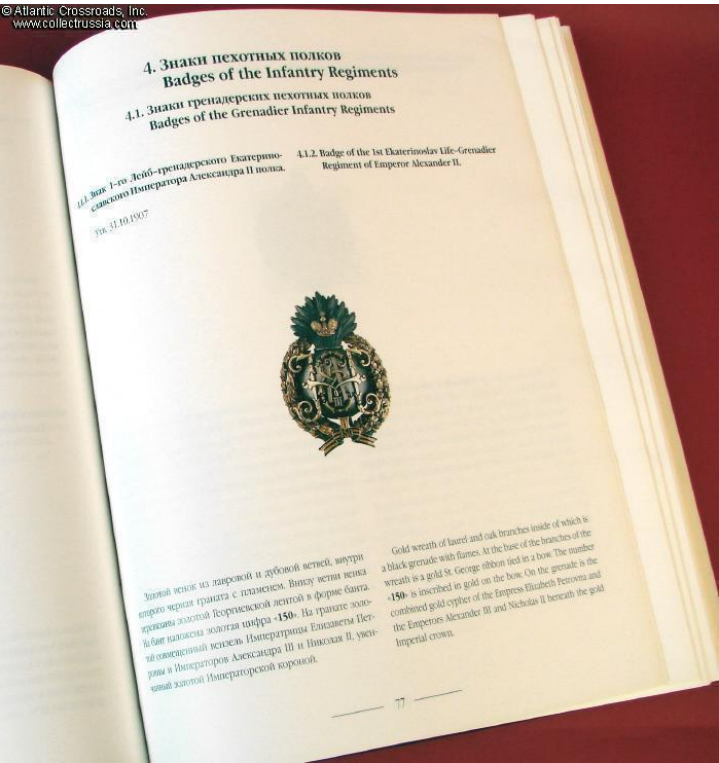
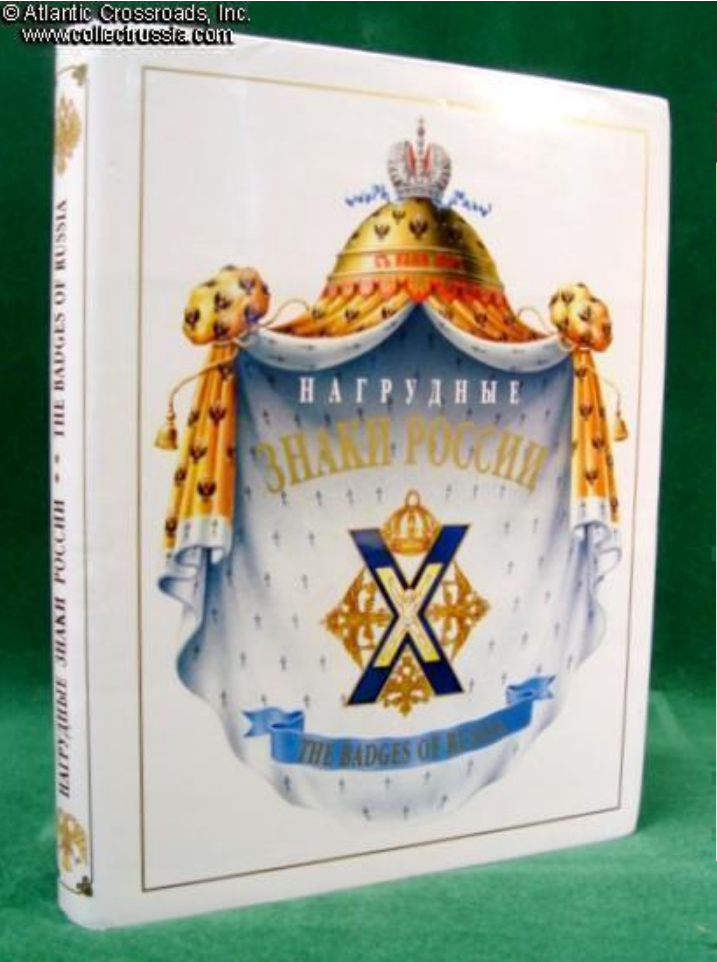

They photographed and fully documented hundreds of specimens found in museums and private collections worldwide. Where original examples could not be found, the authors commissioned accurate color illustrations to take their place. Straight gold cross covered in white enamel on the upper part of which is laid a small oblong double-headed eagle with a gold orb and sceptre between three gold imperial crowns. On the breast of the eagle is a small gold shield covered in red enamel with the gold cypher of Emperor Paul I. In the centre of the cross is also a small gold shield on which is laid a gold oval medallion bearing the Moscow coat of arms beneath the gold imperial crown. On the lateral and lower arms of the cross are the gold cyphers of the Emperors Alexander III, Nicholas II and Peter I beneath gold imperial crowns. The cross is laid on a gold ribbon fixed in a bow covered in red enamel with the gold dates—1796 and 1896 and the gold number—100.

Some examples have inscriptions: *occ. 1904, 1917, 1918* (inv. 109, 176, 171).

Silver double-headed eagle beneath the gold imperial crown. In its claws the eagle is holding crossed cannons (left – gold, right – silver oxidized). On the eagle's breast is the gold cypher of Emperor Nicholas II beneath the gold imperial crown. On the tail of the eagle is a gold Caucasian cross covered in black enamel. In its central gold medallion, covered in black enamel, is the gold number – 100.

Gold wreath of laurel and oak branches crowned with gold Imperial crown. Inside the wreath is the gold cypher of the Emperor Nicholas II. The branches of the wreath are entwined by gold ribbons tied at the base in a bow. The bow is covered with blue enamel with the gold date 4 OCT. 1895 (4 OCT. 1895) and gold inscription «ЗА ЦАРЯ И РОДИНУ» (FOR SERVICE IN MY ESCORT).
