Kazan Institute of Chemical Technology (Kazanskiy Khimiko-Tekhnologicheskiy Institut), graduate badge, circa 1960s-70s.

Gilded brass, enamels; 49.1 x 27.8 mm. Fine quality badge of riveted two-piece construction. The center has Cyrillic abbreviation of the school's name in gold KXT/I ("KKhT/I"). Below it is the inscription on white "Named in honor of S.M. Kirov". The USSR state seal at the top is a separate superimposed part.

In excellent condition. The enamels and gilt finish are perfect. The screw post measures 8 mm long, probably reduced by a couple of mm for convenience, but still fully functional. Includes original screw plate with mint logo.

The current name of the KKhTI is Kazan National Research Technological University. Soviet-era graduation badges of this school are fairly uncommon.
