

Mongolia, Medal for Victory over Japan, Variation 1, #11036, late 1940s.

In gilded brass and enamels, stamped serial number to the reverse (note the relatively low serial number even for the Variation 1). Medallion measures 42.4 mm tall (incl. eyelet), 39.7 mm wide. This is the first version of the medal featuring concave reverse. Excellent quality throughout.

In excellent condition - very uncommon for this award. The gilt is nicely preserved and bright on both the obverse and reverse. The enamel on the star, white Soembo emblem and suspension is essentially perfect, completely free of the usual chips, flaking or even the slightest traces of wear visible to the naked eye. The screw post is of full length, nearly 14 mm, and includes original screw plate marked "Moscow Artists Cooperative".
