

Navy Admiral full dress brocade belt with dagger hangers, dated 1978.

In high quality gold bullion brocade, with a massive nicely detailed two-piece buckle in gilded brass showing anchor and star emblem in high tri-dimensional profile. This is the latest model of the Soviet admiral's belt featuring a yellow liner. The liner has a manufacturer's mark with a 1978 date and an additional quality control stamp. One extra-large size fits all: when fully extended to the maximum allowed by the grommets on the liner, the belt will fit up to 48-inch waist, but it is easily adjustable to almost any smaller size.

In excellent condition. The gold finish of the brass hardware is nice and bright. The gold brocade is free of scuffs or snags. The liner shows only minimal wear, no tears or significant soiling. Overall, an extremely attractive item to display on its own, add to a Soviet admiral's uniform, or complement a late-vintage Soviet dagger (which was used by all naval officer ranks from lieutenant to admiral of the fleet.)

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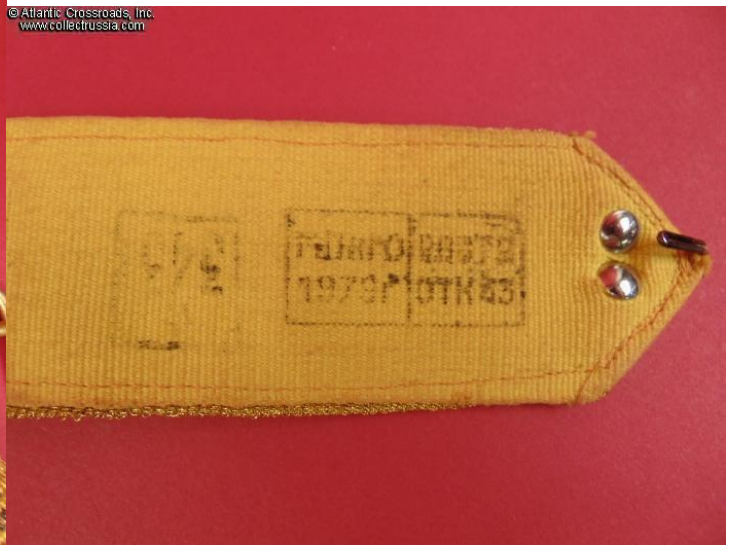
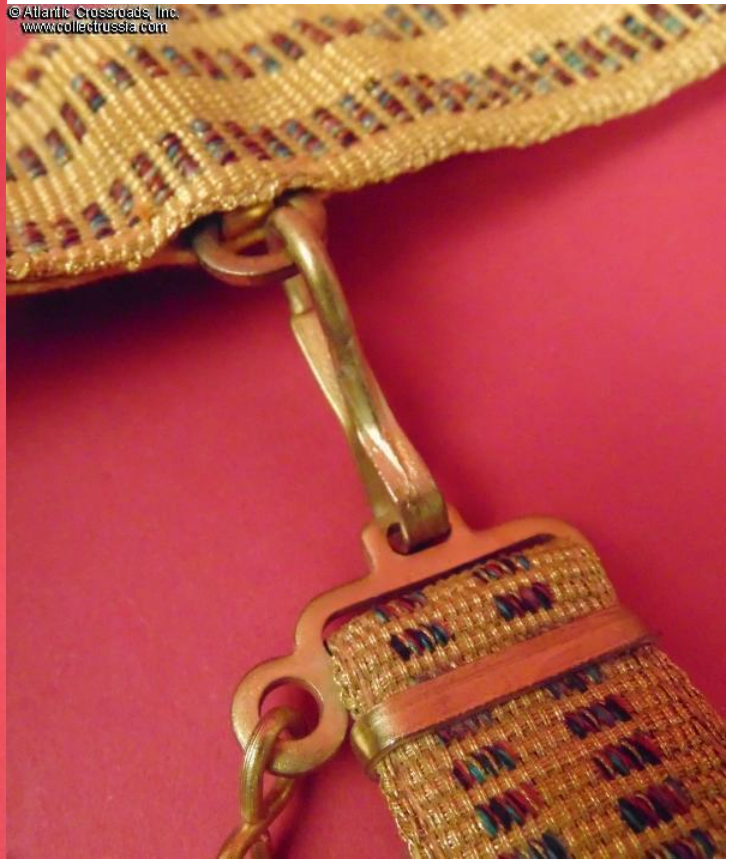


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
