Measures 11" x 8 1/4". Printed on heavy-stock high-quality paper. As stated in the lower right-hand corner of the print, this lithograph was created by etching on steel, and was made in the famous F. Brockhaus Publishing House in Leipzig, Germany. This copy of the etching was published by V. Henkel's Publishing House in St.-Petersburg. The artwork presents 9 incredibly detailed miniature vignettes with images of various countryside palaces in St.-Petersburg's vicinity.

In very good condition. Moderate foxing to the paper attributes to the antique appearance but does nothing to diminish the impression from the filigree of the artwork.

Friedrich Arnold Brockhaus (1772 - 1823) was a German encyclopedia publisher, most famous for his Conversations-Lexikon, which is known and published now as the Brockhaus Encyclopedia, revered for its high standards of quality and veracity of information.
