

Broad Pennant of a Naval Unit or Formation Commander, dated 1978.

In wool bunting, measures 8'2" long, 15 1/2 " across at the hoist. The hoist sleeve shows a 1978 date of manufacture. This type of pennant was hoisted just below the commission pennant on the masthead of the ship of the fleet, large unit or formation commander (above squadron size) while the ship was underway.

Features USSR naval ensign at the base, followed by a slightly tapered red field ending in swallow-tale. The very large size of this pennant made it suitable for some of the largest warships in Soviet naval inventory.

In excellent condition. There is a single tiny moth nip near the hoist, no other noticeable damage. The pennant is completely free of stains, soiling or fading; the colors are strong.
