Measures approx. 80 mm x 105 mm (3 1/4 "x 4 1/4 "); weighs 168.9 g. Nice artwork depicting a black grouse - a traditional Russian game bird - on a tree branch, with vast Siberian forest in the background. Very fine details throughout. . Quite a nice crossover collector piece for the naturalist, hunter or hiker.

Gilded interior showing silver hallmarks "875" with worker's head & hammer symbol, and a character Delta of the Moscow assay inspection. Also shows Cyrillic manufacturer marks ■■4 ("MYu 4") of the Moscow Jewelry and Watch Factory which indicates that 1954 was the year of manufacture.

Excellent condition. The details are essentially pristine, completely free of wear visible to the naked eye. There are no dents, noticeable dings or significant scratches. The cabochon is intact and the closure functions smoothly. The gilt finish on the inside is extremely well preserved and bright.
