

Soviet Pennant for Numeral Four (4) of both the Russian Nautical Code ("Четверка") and International Nautical Code ("Kartefour"), dated 1952.

In wool bunting, same quality and construction as the typical Soviet Navy ensign and other naval flags of the period. Measures approx. 36" x 23". Comes with a long attachment rope in natural hemp (as opposed to synthetic thread as seen on later Soviet flags), complete with metal hardware to hoist on the line. The hoist sleeve shows markings of the Nabivtkan Factory, quality control stamp, and a 1952 date of manufacture.

The flag is in excellent condition. It is free of any moth damage. There are a couple of very faint stains to the grey field near the far end that are barely noticeable, no significant staining or soiling. The flag is completely sound, and the colors are bright, not showing any fading.
