



Medal Commemorating the 300th Anniversary of the Romanov Dynasty, 1913.

In brass, measures 28.2 mm in width; weighs 13.9 g not including the suspension and connecting link. In very fine condition. There is mild wear to the high points of the artwork on the obverse, but the raised details of the bas-relief portraits are nevertheless well-defined. The reverse shows almost no wear; the details of the lettering are nice and crisp. The toning to the brass is very uniform and attractive on both sides, free of significant blemishes or oxidation spots. The medal comes on a Soviet-era suspension with a new Romanov ribbon.
