Order of the Badge of Honor, Type 4, Variation 1, #564793, circa mid- to late-1960s.

Silver gilt, enamels; 49.8 mm tall (incl. eyelet) x 33.4 mm wide; weighs 32.1 g not including the suspension and connecting link. Features separate letters "CCCP" and rotating tool engraved serial number with a well-defined raised underline. According to Mondvor.narod.ru, this is Type 4 Var. 2, Sub-var. 4, with the currently known serial number range from 422442 - 855107.

In outstanding, excellent condition. The enamel is perfect, free of any wear or contact marks visible even under a 10x magnification. The raised details of the male and female workers on the obverse and stippling on the reverse are essentially pristine with the exception of a few microscopic contact marks that are completely unnoticeable to the naked eye. Comes on original two-layer suspension in steel with nicely preserved, clean old ribbon. The connecting link appears to be original; its ends are still joined with solder. Overall, a superb example that is literally impossible to upgrade condition-wise!
