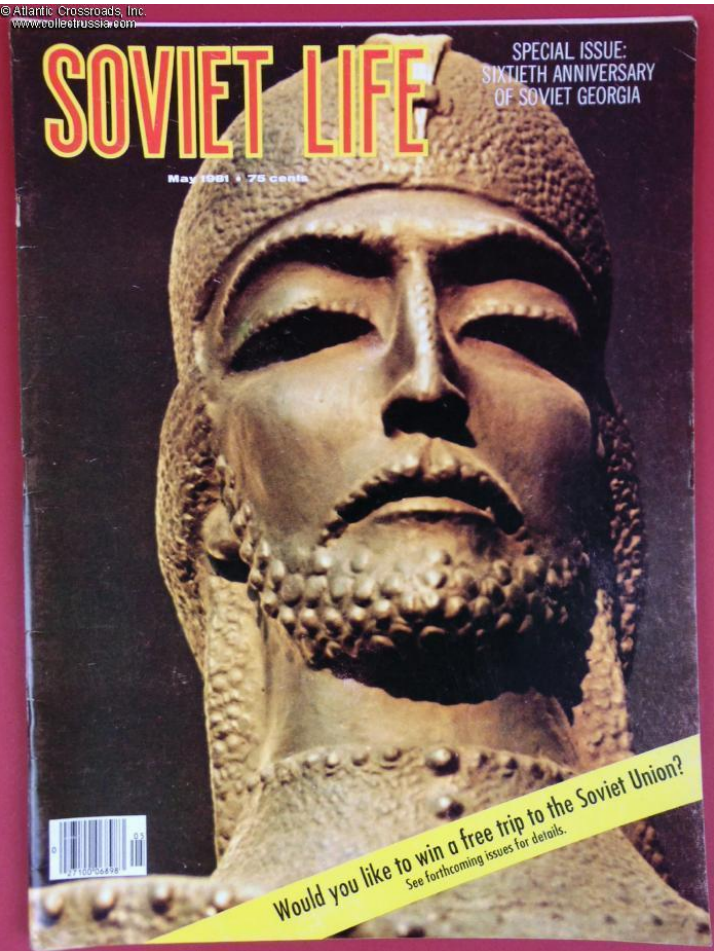
Almost the entire issue is dedicated to covering the life, work and leisure, industry and culture of the people of Soviet republic of Georgia.
