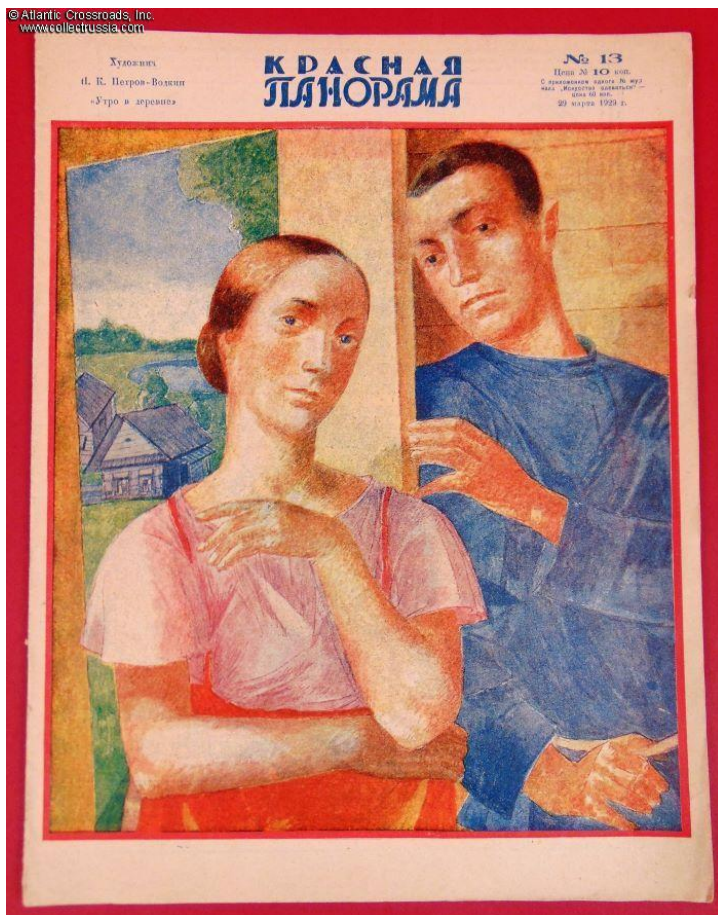
In very good condition. Very mild age toning to the paper, small separations at the fold to the cover, top and bottom, and minuscule corner bumps complete the list of age wear. The color graphics on the cover as well as the photos and text of the internal pages are amazingly bright and clear.

The magazine evidently works on quite a new angle of Soviet propaganda. All the textual material and photos are a subtle tapestry where Soviet propaganda is not rudely pushed but smoothly interwoven into material about foreign and domestic events and personalities.
