

Krasnaya Panorama ("Red Panorama") issue # 22, May 31, 1929, Soviet magazine dedicated to propaganda of the Soviet way of life through international coverage of political, cultural, scientific and other events and personalities.

Measures 11 3/4" x 9", 16 pp. excluding the cover. Printed on thin low-quality paper. Only the cover has graphics and text in color. The internal pages are uniformly b/w. Published by Red Newspaper, Leningrad. Circulation 110,000.

In fair to good condition. Very mild age toning to the paper, microscopic separations to the cover at the fold, top and bottom, minuscule corner bumps, a rip along the top edge of the front cover. A few light and faded stains mostly blend in with the age-toned paper. The color graphics on the cover as well as the photos and text of the internal pages are amazingly bright and clear.

The magazine evidently works on quite a new angle of Soviet propaganda. All the textual material and photos are a subtle tapestry where Soviet propaganda is not rudely pushed but smoothly interwoven into material about foreign and domestic events and personalities creating a mosaic of domestic achievements and trouble abroad.
