

Medal for the Liberation of Prague, Variation 2, 1940s-50s.

In brass; measures 37.2 mm in height incl. eyelet, 32.1 mm in width; weighs 17.7 g not including the suspension and connecting link. Features U-shaped eyelet.

In outstanding, excellent condition. The medal is free of wear visible to the naked eye beside a couple of miniscule dings to the raised edge; otherwise, there are only a few microscopic contact marks that are completely unnoticeable without magnification. The raised details are perfect and exceptionally crisp. The original "gilt" mint luster is very well preserved and bright throughout showing only a light toning and very minor amount of tarnish on the reverse that adds character - no blemishes or significant oxidation. Comes on original suspension device, a single layer model in brass. The perfectly preserved and clean ribbon shows age, although it is of more recent vintage than the medal itself. The connecting link appears to be of the period.
