

Postcard To School, 1958.

The size is continental 6" x 4", postally unused and unmarked. The artwork depicts a schoolgirl, a first- or second-grader as she is not wearing the young pioneers' red tie, getting ready for school on the 1st of September. Her little brother is holding her school bag and a bouquet of flowers with a dreamy and a little envious smile, wishing he were old enough to go to school too. Published by IZOGIZ, circulation 800,000 copies. The back is divided, the artist's name, G. Bedarev, is printed in the lower left-hand corner.

In very good condition. The artwork is crisp and clear, the colors and the text bright and vibrant. The corner bumps are barely visible and not at all detractive. The paper is mildly age-toned, a little more pronounced at the edges, not reaching the artwork. The back is mostly clean, showing just minimal storage wear.
