

Silver Beaker on a Ring Foot, dated 1882.

Stands slightly over 9 cm (3.5") tall, approx. 48 mm wide at the top, the base is approx. 42.5 mm in diameter; weighs 46.3 g. Decorated with hand-engraved florals. Near the top, there are Latin characters "LB", apparently the initials of the original owner who, judging by the use of the Latin alphabet, was of non-Russian ethnicity. Also located in the same area just under the brim are the "84" silver hallmark of the St. Petersburg assay inspection and a maker's hallmark. The latter is poorly struck and mostly illegible, but the last two digits "82" of the 1882 date of manufacture are nevertheless clearly visible.

In excellent condition. The beaker is completely free of dents or noticeable scratches. The exterior has acquired a very attractive even patina.
