

Propaganda Poster Let Children Grow.

..., artist signed, dated 1975.

Large format, measures 22 x 34". Published by PLAKAT ("Poster") Publishers, Moscow, circulation 250,000 copies. The name of the artist, B. Berezovsky, is printed in the lower left-hand corner. The artwork is a photo of a young boy feeding pigeons in Moscow's Red Square. The lettering below reads, "Let children grow on the sunny planet - our happiness, our joy!"

In fair to good condition. The poster is printed on rather thin uncoated paper and has acquired some minor edge rips and bumps, not too intrusive to the eye on the large area of the poster. The largest of the rips has been repaired with library tape. If desired, all the edges are easy enough to reinforce with library tape. The right side shows traces of some dry red pigment. It is much more obvious on the reverse while the imagery on the obverse makes it less detractive. There are some stains at bottom left, some oily substance that soaked from the reverse to the obverse. The stains are obvious but faint and not reaching the lettering. There is also a bit of creasing to the paper. In a way, it adds character and authenticity to the poster, like watching an old movie on an old scratchy film.

Please note that the pen in our last photo is for size reference.

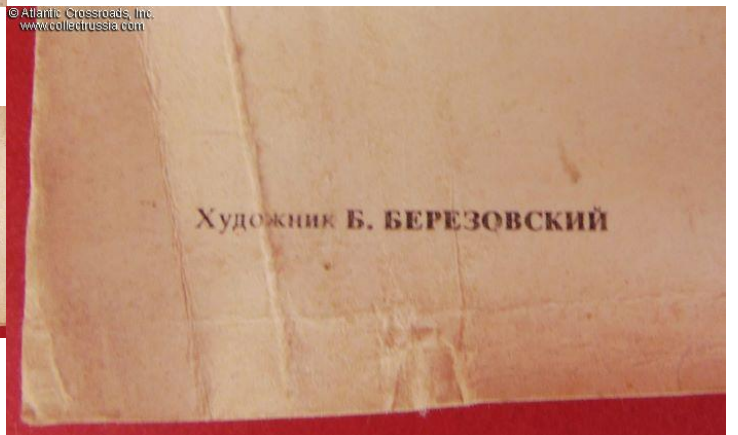
