

Honorary Certificate issued on 2 July 1950 to N. Deryuzhko (Н.Ф. Дерюжко), a member of the Lokomotiv (Локомотив) soccer team, winner of the cup of the 1950 championship of BMASSR (Buryat-Mongol Autonomous Soviet Socialist Republic).

Single page, 8 1/4" x 11 1/2". The certificate was issued by the Committee for matters of physical culture and sports at the Council of Ministers of BMASSR, bears serial number 460 and is hand-signed by the Chairman of the Committee.

The ornamental frame and textual part of the certificate are anchored by the image of the Ready for Labor and Defense badge, 2nd (the highest) level, top center. Beneath it is the formulation of the importance of physical culture and fitness from the Soviet perspective. It reads "Physical culture is a powerful means of preparing healthy, active and dedicated fighters for socialism".

In good to very good condition. The paper shows mild to moderate storage wear, including, all in minor degrees, foxing, soiling, corner bumps and even tiny edge rips. However, none of the wear is significant enough to be really detractive. All the artwork, typographical and typed text, as well as the seal and hand signature of the chairman of the committee are perfectly clear and legible.
