

Electric Samovar, dated 1983, brand-new unused condition.

In nickel-plated brass. Stands approx. 15" tall including the crown, about 10" handle to handle, square base approx. 5" across. Maximum capacity 2.5 L (0.66 US gallon). Electric specs: 220V, 1kW. Includes the original 5.5-foot-long power cord.

In brand-new, unused condition. There is a tiny amount of verdigris around the escutcheon plate and inside the round openings of the valve handle. Nickel plating shows minimal deterioration from improper storage (Soviet warehouses were typically not climate-controlled).

This samovar stands out in the elegant simplicity of its smooth bucket-shaped jug, compared to the typically ribbed design of the Soviet-era electric samovars.

This samovar is perfect for display on a kitchen counter or a dining room buffet. We've even seen these placed dramatically at one end of a recreation room bar or sideboard amongst bottles of wine and vodka.

While this samovar appears to be in perfect working condition, we do not encourage its use for any purpose other than display, and make absolutely no warranties of its suitability or safety, even with appropriate electric adapter to the US voltage, amperage, and power cord connector.
