

Early WW1 Lithographic Poster Skirmish at the Austrian Border, 1914.

Measures 18 1/2" x 15", in vibrant fresh colors, printed by the S. Mukharskiy Lithography Printing House, Moscow. The caption under the lithograph describes the details of an 18-hour-long skirmish at the village of Gonka at the Austrian border. The fight started with a heavy cannonade, followed by hand-to-hand combat which the Russian troops won, leaving 2,000 Austrian troops killed and wounded and capturing 4,000 more.

In excellent, outstanding condition. The paper has a like-new feel and is just a little age-toned; the colors are bright and vibrant, there is no fraying of the edges or corner bumps.
