



Photo ID Issued to Grigory Motrenko, a Member of the All-Army Military Hunters Society, 1947.

Measures 4" x 3" when closed, in cloth-wrapped hard cover. This ID, though dated February 1947, was issued on the old blank form with "НКО" (Russian abbreviation for People's Commissariat of Defense) on the cover even though People's Commissariats were changed into Ministries in 1946, and Narkomat of Defense became Ministry of the Armed Forces of the USSR. The ID photo has been removed, as evidenced by the missing part of the seal and dried glue in the placeholder. The booklet has pages for registering membership renewals, the member's firearm(s), purchase of firearms and ammunition, resident status, and hunting dogs. The last pages are for lists of animals and fowl prohibited for hunting, and for recording violations and fines.

In good to very good condition. The cloth of the cover is worn off at the corners, and some of the internal pages are separated from the binding. The paper of the internal pages is moderately age-toned and a little brittle but still pliable enough to allow turning the pages. All the pages are in place. The lettering on the front cover is bright.
