

Highest School of Civil Aviation Pilots, graduate badge, circa late 1970s-1980s issue.

Anodized aluminum, enamels; 49.6 x 27.1 mm. Two-piece construction: the center medallion with Aeroflot wings is a separate superimposed part. Features high-quality translucent enamels on the background diamond and lesser quality "cold" enamel on the center medallion with the Aeroflot emblem. The reverse has the late-style raised logo of the Leningrad Mint.

Excellent condition. There are minuscule hairlines to the white border at the top, practically unnoticeable to the naked eye and not affecting the integrity of the enamel; the enamel is otherwise perfect and shows a very attractive luster. The anodized gold finish is bright and free of tarnish. The screw post is full length, over 7 mm measured from the retaining nut, and includes original screw plate with the raised Leningrad mint inscription.

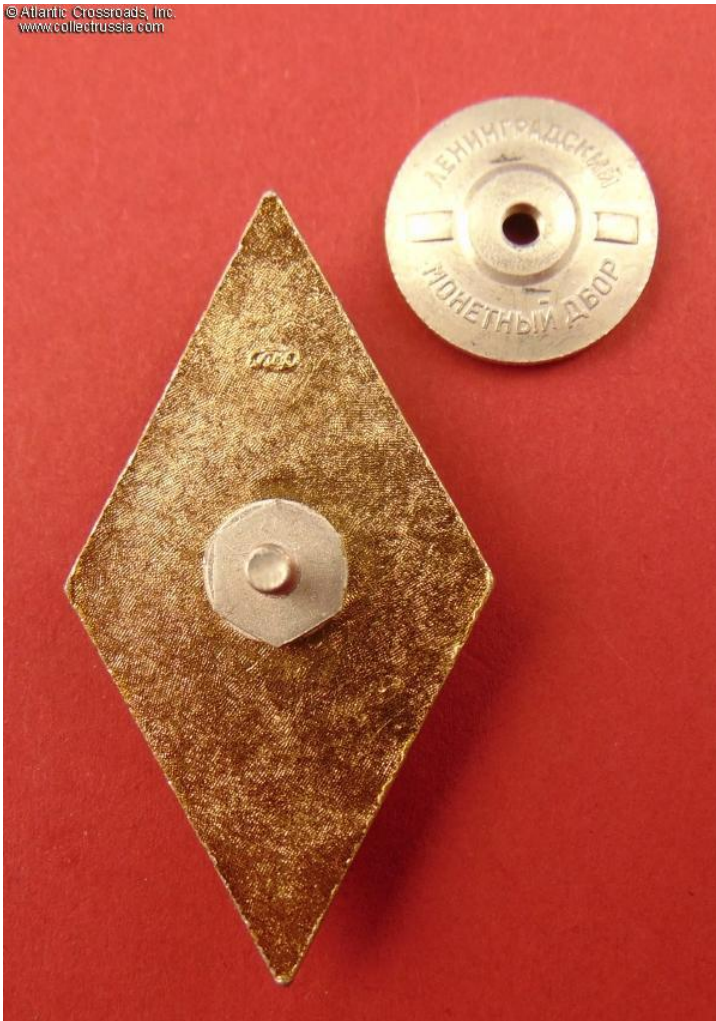

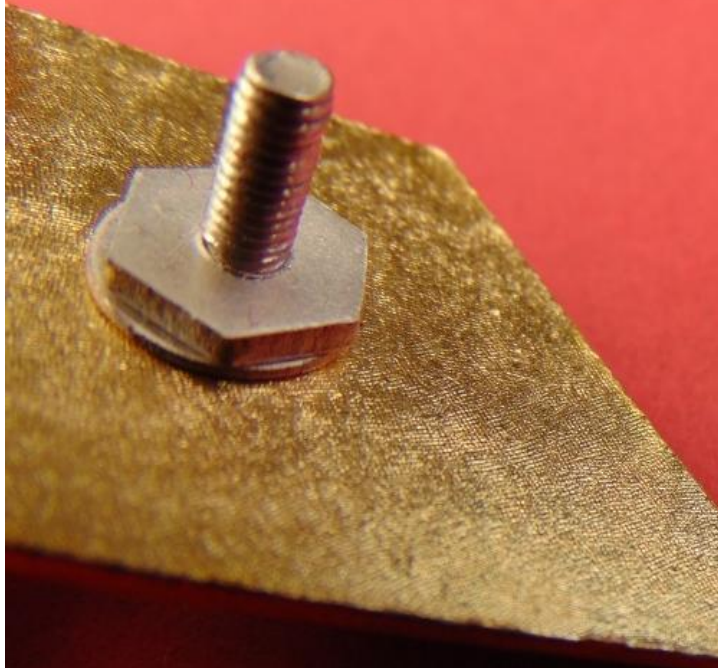

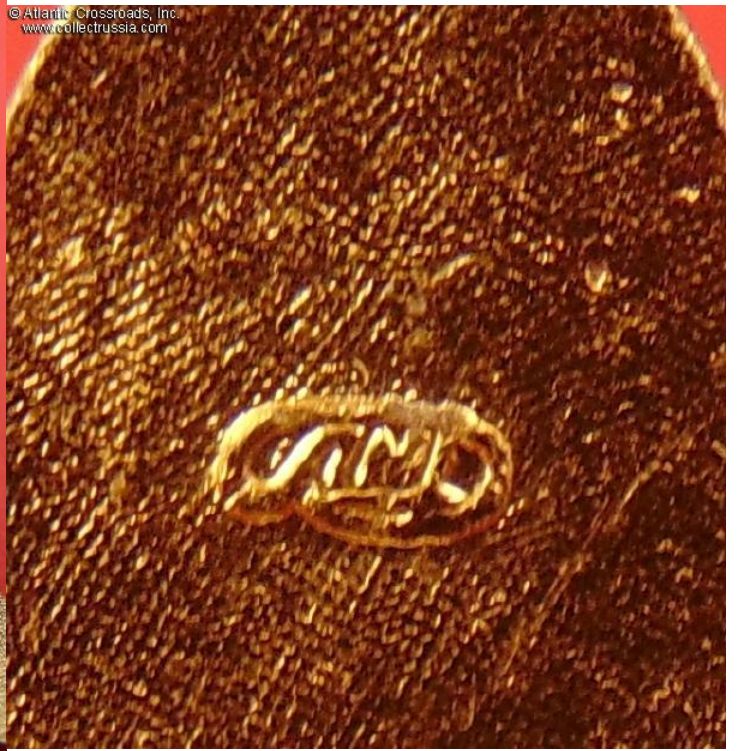
