

Pass photo ID #340 issued on 31 December 1964 to Tank Corps Major General (retired) Sergey Lebedev.

Booklet measuring 3" x 2 1/2", in oilcloth-wrapped hard cover. The pass was issued for entry to the territory of a military unit. Unfortunately, the number of the unit is unclear on the stamps.

In very good to excellent condition. The cover shows very minor storage wear. The left page inside has become slightly unglued under the photo, and shows an uneven lower edge. The ID photo is in sharp focus and pristine condition.

Tank Corps Major General Sergey Lebedev was decorated with two Orders of Lenin, three Orders of the Red Banner, two Orders of Suvorov 2nd class, Order of the Patriotic War 1st class, and Order of the Red Star. He began his service in the Red Army in 1928. During WW2, he rose from battalion commander with the 62nd Rifle Division to Chief of Staff of the 6th Guards Tank Corps, 3rd Guards Tank Army. He finished his military career as Chief of the Combat Readiness Department of the 14th Army. In 1958, Lebedev was retired with the right to wear military uniform. He died on 17 September 1965, less than a year after this pass had been issued.
