



## Jetton in Commemoration of the 200th Anniversary of St Petersburg, 1903.

In silver; measures 28.2 mm in height incl. eyelet, 24.5 mm wide; weighs 6.7 g. The obverse features a portrait of Peter I, the founder of the city, and inscription "Emperor Peter the Great". The reverse has the St. Petersburg's coat of arms of crossed anchors and scepter, banners topped with double-headed eagle, and raised inscription "In Commemoration of the 200th Anniversary of the of St Petersburg, 1703-1903."

In outstanding, excellent condition. The details of the artwork on both sides are extremely well-preserved and crisp, nearly pristine. There are some small dings to the raised edge but no significant scratches or any other flaws (other than typical manufacturing imperfections). A very attractive even toning to silver throughout.

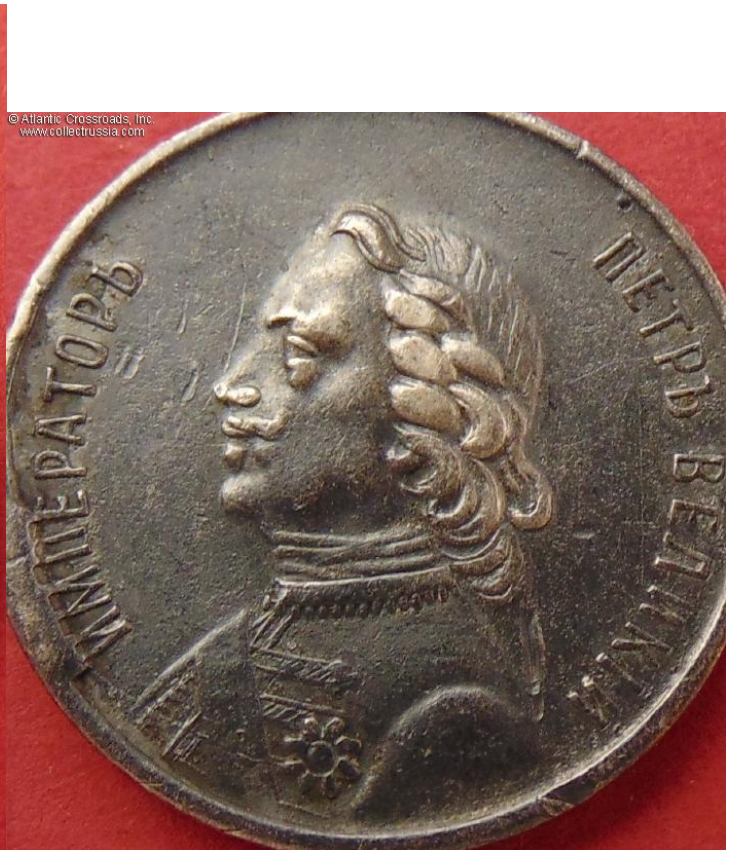
Souvenir jettons such as this one were sold throughout the city during the anniversary celebrations. Most however were in brass, including the brass version of the piece offered here. The silver version of this jetton is fairly scarce, especially in a premium condition.
