

### Government Postcard V. Lenin on the Way to Petrograd, 1957.

The size is continental standard 6" x 4", postally unused, with a pre-printed postal stamp showing the Spasskaya Clock Tower of the Moscow Kremlin. Published by the Ministry of Communications of the USSR, circulation unknown. The artwork is an offset print of a painting by P. Vasilyev, depicting Lenin surrounded by Russian Imperial Army soldiers, most likely in the middle of some communist propaganda speech.

In excellent condition, showing only tiny corner bumps and some mild discoloration to the verso due to uneven exposure to light. The ink stamp on the verso says that the price of the postcard will be 4 kopeks after 1 January 1961, the date when Khrushchev's 10:1 currency reform went into effect.
